



# Ride PATCO to the “Camden Rising” Concert at the BB&T Pavilion Thursday, July 28

## ABOUT PATCO

PATCO is a rapid transit system which runs between Philadelphia and Camden County, New Jersey. Opened in 1969, PATCO operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and transports more than 10.1 million riders annually. It is a subsidiary of the Delaware River Port Authority (DRPA).

## HOW TO GET TO THE BB&T PAVILION

Board an eastbound train at PATCO's 8th & Market Station in Philadelphia and ride to Broadway Station/Walter Rand Transportation Center in Camden, NJ.

### Upon exiting Broadway Station:

- 1. WALK.** Head west on Martin Luther King Blvd. towards the Camden Waterfront. It's approximately a 15 minute walk and 0.7 miles.
- 2. TRAIN.** Transfer to the NJTRANSIT RiverLine. The RiverLINE will take you right to the BB&T entrance. For fares & schedule, visit [www.njtransit.com](http://www.njtransit.com)
- 3. TAXI.** Taxis may be available at the corner of Broadway & MLK Blvd.
